This week at school...

In math we have been discussing place value. We talked about how 10 ones equal 1 ten, 10 tens equal 1 hundred and 10 hundreds equal 1 thousand. We bundled straws into groups of tens and hundreds to help us count up to 1,000 trading up each time we cross a decade. We have also leaned all the ways to represent a number (expanded form, word form, base 10 blocks etc)

In writing we have finished our PBA (Performance Based Assessment) Students had to write a compare and contrast paper about two communities we learned in our book Friends Around the World.! They were expected to write at least four complete sentences discussing how the communities are alike and different. I will be grading those next week and kids will put their scores on Seesaw soon after that.

In Science we learned about bodies of water on October 20, 2017 the Earth. The students learned how each body of water has been created by a single drop of water. We also learned about water in the forms of liquids, solids, and gases. We are now learning about groundwater and pollution.
